



## Initial setup instructions


### 1. Connect to power.




Ⓢ Attention:  
Connect the power cord to the AC power adapter firmly. Poor connections may result in damage to the AC power adapter.

Note: To prevent over-discharging, the battery pack of the computer is placed in Ship Mode at the factory. While the battery is in Ship Mode, it will not provide power to the computer. Connect your computer to the supplied AC power adapter before first use. The battery pack will be activated instantly when the computer is connected to AC power.

### 2. Press the power button.

## Using headphones or earphones


