

Xiaomi **mijia** Smart Air Purifier MAX User Manual



Read this manual carefully before use, and retain it for future reference.

WARNINGS

- When the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced with a genuine power cord purchased from the manufacturer or after-sales service department.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Make sure the air purifier is turned off and unplugged before performing the maintenance.
- This appliance contains a UV-C emitter.
- Do not replace the UV-C emitter.
- Unintended use of the appliance or damage to the housing may result in the escape of dangerous UV-C radiation. UV-C radiation may, even in little doses, cause harm to the eyes and skin.
- Appliances that are obviously damaged must not be operated.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical/sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

Safety Instructions

- Make sure the power cord is fully inserted into and makes reliable contact with the power outlet.
- When an extension cord is needed, use one that meets national standards.
- Unplug the air purifier before you leave.
- In case of abnormal noise, odor, high temperature, or malfunction, stop using the air purifier immediately, and then turn it off and unplug it.
- Power supply to the air purifier should not be drawn from a lamp holder with a power outlet.
- The total rated current value of household appliances connected to an extension cord should not exceed the rated current value of the original fixed outlet or circuit.
- Do not use the air purifier near flammables or explosives, or in similar environments.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the air purifier or change the internal wiring, components, or protective devices.
- Do not unplug the air purifier by pulling the power cord.
- Do not attempt to replace the fuses of the air purifier and the power supply with ordinary electric conductors or fuses that exceed the specified current capacity.
- Do not attempt to change the setting values of the low-voltage circuit breaker or residual current device.
- Unplug the air purifier before performing cleaning and maintenance or moving it.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

Moving

- ▲ Before moving the air purifier, set it on standby and unplug it.

Installation

- If the filter or filter compartment cover is not properly installed, the air purifier cannot be turned on.
- Place the air purifier at least 25 cm from walls or other obstructions.

Cleaning

- Cleaning the dust, hair, and impurities on the surface of the filter frequently may help reduce bacterial growth.
- Removing dust and impurities from the air inlet grille may prevent a reduction in air intake volume.
- When the air purifier is not used for an extended period, store it in the packaging box, or cover the air inlet/outlet grilles and filter compartment cover, to prevent dust buildup.
- It is recommended to clean the air purifier every 3 months.

Power Supply

To avoid fire, electric shock, and other damage, use the power cord and power outlet as instructed:

- Do not excessively pull, twist, or bend the power cord, as this may expose or break its core.
- Use only the power outlet that matches the power cord.
- Use the power cord provided with the air purifier rather than any third-party power cord.

During Use

- In case of abnormal noise, odor, high temperature, or irregular fan rotation, stop using the air purifier immediately.
- Do not insert your fingers or any objects into the air inlet/outlet grilles or filter compartment cover.
- Keep hair or fabrics away from the air purifier to prevent them from being caught in or blocking the air inlet/outlet grilles.
- Do not sit on, lean on, or tilt the air purifier.
- When using the air purifier in conjunction with household gas-fueled appliances (gas stoves, gas heaters, etc.), ensure adequate ventilation to avoid carbon monoxide poisoning.
- Do not pour liquids or throw powders or other small substances into the air purifier through the air inlet/outlet grilles or filter compartment cover.

Usage Restrictions

- Avoid prolonged use in high-fume environments, as this may accelerate filter failure.
- Do not place the air purifier on unstable surfaces where it may tip over.
- Do not place the air purifier in hot, humid, or damp environments such as bathrooms.

Do not use the air purifier in the following circumstances, as this may result in fire, electric shock, or other damage:

- ▲ Keep the product, especially the air inlet grille, away from open-flame appliances (candles, incense burners, stoves, fireplaces, cigarettes, firecrackers, lighters, electronic ignition spray guns, candle lighters, fire pans, etc.).
- ▲ Keep the product away from high-temperature heat-generating appliances (electric heaters, fan heaters, foot warmers, electric stoves, electric irons, etc.), and prevent flammables from entering it.

Note: The equipment will use and save the Wi-Fi name and password for network connection.

Enabling/Disabling Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi is enabled by default. When the air purifier is on, simultaneously press and hold the brightness button and mode button for 7 seconds to enable or disable Wi-Fi.
Wi-Fi indicator lights up when Wi-Fi is enabled, and goes off when Wi-Fi is disabled.

Care & Maintenance

Warning: Set the air purifier on standby and unplug it before performing the following operations.

Clean laser particle sensor

Open the cover with a non-sharp tool as illustrated, and then clean the filter mesh and the laser particle sensor with an air gun or hair dryer.

CAUTION: Do not use hot air.

Clean air purifier

Wipe the dust from the exterior with a soft cloth.
Open the filter compartment cover to remove the filter, and then clean the filter compartment.
It is recommended to clean the air purifier every 3 months.

CAUTION:
Do not rinse or spray the exterior directly with water, or wipe it with a dripping cloth, to prevent water droplets from entering the air purifier.

Replacing Filter

Warning: Set the air purifier on standby and unplug it before performing the following operations. Unwrap the packaging of the filter before installing it.

Open the filter compartment cover and grip the pull-tab to remove the old filter. Then, install the new filter. Make sure the pull-tab is facing outward and upward. Finally, close the filter compartment cover.

Note: To ensure optimal performance, please replace the two filters at the same time.
