Read these instructions carefully before starting; follow the safety guidelines and keep them for later.

We recommend that you build the models in the order presented. This will help you understand how the different parts are in one another; you will then be able to design numerous other models.

This set is intended for children from 8 years old, and designed to build different models, to make children discover and learn.

Make sure the children follow the safety guidelines and are aware of the possible risks before they start to build the models.

Caution! Never plug the plugs or other components into an outlet! This can result in electric shock and injury or damage. Only use the appropriate batteries for this kit.

Cleaning: Remove the batteries before cleaning. Clean only with a slightly damp cloth.



Not suitable for children under 6 years.

- Contains small parts and cord, there is a risk of suffocation and strangulation. This kit may contain chemicals that can be harmful in the event of improper use.
- Carefully read the warnings and instructions in the manual.
- This set should always be used under the supervision of an adult.
- Keep the packaging and the manual for future use.

Keep it out of reach of very young children.

- Always place batteries according to the +/- symbols.
- Only use suitable batteries.
- Do not use nickel-cadmium (Ni-Cd) rechargeable batteries.
- Replace the batteries all together.
- Do not mix new and old batteries.
- Do not use alkaline and carbon-zinc batteries.
- Try charging non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not short-circuit the polarity of the batteries. Do not throw the batteries into a fire.
- Remove batteries when they are not used for a long period of time.
- Do not leave worn batteries. They can leak and cause damage.
- Batteries are Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) and do not belong with the normal household waste. Bring them for recycling to the known collection points.
