
BATTERY INSTALLATION INTO THE MAIN UNIT




- 1. Open battery compartment.
- 2. Insert 8 batteries (type: R-20, UM-1 or D-cells) with correct polarity (+/-) as indicated.
- 3. Close the battery compartment.

BATTERY INSTALLATION INTO THE REMOTE CONTROL



Press down on the compartment cover, and slide the cover off to open the compartment.

Place the one CR2025 battery in the remote control according to the polarity markings ("+" and "-") inside the compartment and on the battery.

Place the cover into the compartment, press down lightly, and push it inside until it snaps on.



- 1. If the remote control is not in use for long periods, the battery will become weak and the remote control will not function, please replace with a new one if the above happens.
- 2. The battery of remote control shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.

TURN ON

Press \circlearrowleft on main unit or remote control, the system switches to the last selected source. To select another source, press \circlearrowleft /SOURCE button on main unit or **SOURCE** button on remote control repeatedly.

SWITCH TO STANDBY MODE

- 1. Press and hold 1 button 2 seconds on main unit or press 1 button once on remote control to switch the system to standby mode.
 - The clock (if set) appears on the display panel.
- 2. The display backlight becomes dim.



In CD, USB, Bluetooth mode, the system stays inactive for 15 minutes, it switches to standby mode automatically.

In AUX mode, if music is stopped or paused for 15 minutes and the 3.5mm cable is not plugged, the system switches to standby mode automatically.

SET CLOCK

- In standby mode, press and hold PROG/CLK.SET on main unit or remote control for two seconds. The 12/24-hour format appeared
- 2. Press I◄◄ / ▶▶I repeatedly to select an hour format.
- 3. Press PROG/CLK.SET to confirm. Then hour digits blink.
- 4. Repeat steps 2-3 to set the hour.
- 5. Repeat steps 2-3 to set the minute



If the system is idle for 10 seconds, it exits clock setting mode automatically.

PLAY OPTIONS

Control

In CD or USB/SD mode:

 ◄◄ / >>	Select an audio file; Press and hold to fast forward or fast reverse the track during playback, then release to resume play.
FOLDER ◀ ▶	On remote control only: For MP3 tracks, press FOLDER ◀ ▶ button to select an album or folder.
+10	Press to skip the tracks in 10 multiples.
►/II	Start or pause play.
-	Stop play.

PLAY

Play disc

- 1. In CD mode
- 2. Lift up the CD door.
- 3. Insert a disc with the printed side facing up.
- 4. Close the CD door.
- 5. Press SOURCE on the main unit or remote control to select the disc source.
 - Display shown "- -", then CD starts playing automatically.
 - If not, press ►II.

PLAY FROM A USB STORAGE DEVICE/SD-MMC CARD



Make sure that the USB device or memory card contains playable audio content.

- 1. Insert the USB storage device into the USB socket.
- Press SOURCE to select the USB.
 - Play starts automatically. If not, press ►II.

Note:

Please do NOT use a USB extension cable to connect your USB flash drive.

Such cable can pick up additional interference which can corrupt the data flow. Always connect your USB flash derive directly to the USB port without USB extension cable.

- 1. Insert the SD or MMC card into the card slot.
- 2. Press SOURCE to select the SD.
 - Play starts automatically. If not, press ►II.

PLAY FROM BLUETOOTH-ENABLE DEVICES



- The effective operating range between the system and the paired device is approximately 10 meters (30 feet).
- Any obstacle between the system and the device can reduce the operational range.
- Compatibility with all Bluetooth devices is not guaranteed.
- This system is auto enable Bluetooth pairing mode.
- 1. Press **SOURCE** to select Bluetooth source. The [bt] text blinks and [x] is displayed.
- 2. On your Bluetooth device, enable Bluetooth and search for Bluetooth devices that can be paired (refer to the user manual of the device).
- 3. When [SPT 4700] is displayed on your device, select it to start pairing and connection.

After successful pairing and connection, the [bt] text goes stabiles (connected) and heard music sound.

4. Play audio on your device. Audio streams from your device to this micro system.

MANUAL PAIRING THE BLUETOOTH-ENABLE DEVICE

- 1. In bt mode if paired device.
- 2. Press **PAIRING** button 3 seconds to enable pairing mode, the [**bt**] is displayed and blink.
- 3. On your Bluetooth device, enable Bluetooth and search for Bluetooth devices that can be paired (refer to the user manual of the device).
- 4. When [SPT 4700] is displayed on your device, select it to start pairing and connection.

After successful pairing and connection, the $[\mathbf{bt}]$ text goes stabiles (connected) and heard music sound.

5. Play audio on your device. Audio streams from your device to this micro system.

TO DISCONNECT THE BLUETOOTH-ENABLE DEVICE

Deactivate Bluetooth on your device; or Move the device beyond the communication range.

PLAY MODE [REPEAT]

In CD or USB/SD mode:

Press REPEAT button on main unit or remote control repeatedly to select different play mode.

REPEAT: Play the current track repeatedly.
REPEAT ALL: Play all tracks repeatedly.
RANDOM: [RAND] play all tracks randomly.

To return to normal play, press REPEAT button repeatedly unit all icon disappeared.

PROGRAM TRACKS

You can program a maximum of 20 tracks on CD disc or 99 tracks on MP3 disc.

- 1. In CD, USB or SD mode, press STOP button to stop playback.
- 2. Press PROG/CLK to active the programming mode. [PROG] [P 01] is displayed and blinks.
- 3. For MP3 / WMA tracks, press FOLDER ◀ / ▶ repeatedly to select an album.
- 4. Press I◄◄ / ▶▶I repeatedly to select a track, then press PROG/CLK.SET to confirm.
- 5. Repeat steps 3-4 to program more tracks.
- To play the programmed tracks, press ►II.
 During play, [PROG] is displayed
 To erase the program, press STOP button twice.

ADJUST SOUND [EQ]

During play, you can adjust volume and select different sound effects.

- Turns the volume knob on the top of main unit or press the VOL -/+ button for increase or decrease volume level on remote control.
- 2. Press the MUTE on remote control to mute or resume sound.
- Press EQ button on main unit or remote control to select a sound effect; [ROCK] > [POPS] > [JAZZ] > [CLASSIC]

MUTE [REMOTE CONTROL ONLY]

- 1. Press the MUTE button on remote control
- 2. Display show L 00 and blinks.
- 3. To resume the volume, press the MUTE button again to disable MUTE function.

FM RADIO

Tune to FM radio stations

Position the antenna as far as possible from TV, power adapter or other radiation source.

- Press SOURCE repeatedly to select FM tuner mode
- Press SCAN button to perform auto scan or
 Press and hold I◄◄ / ▶►I for 3 seconds to search FM station with strong reception automatically.
- 3. Repeat step 2 to tune to more stations.

To tune to a station with weak signal:

Turns the Tuning knob on top of main unit or press I◄◄ / ▶►I repeatedly on remote control until you find good reception.

PROGRAM FM RADIO STATION

You can program a maximum of 40 pre-set FM radio stations.

- 1. In FM tuner mode, tune to desired FM radio station
- Press PROG/CLK.SET button to activate programming mode. [PROG] and [P01] displayed and [01] blinks.
- 3. Press PRESET ◀ / ▶ on remote control repeatedly to select a channel number.
- 4. Press PROG/CLK.SET again to confirm
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 to store other FM stations.

To remove a pre-stored station, store another station in its place.

SELECT A PRE-SET RADIO STATION

In RADIO mode, press PRESET button on main unit or PRESET ◀ / ▶ on remote control to select a pre-set number.

Select stereo /mono broadcast

- Stereo broadcast is the default setting for tuner mode.
- For stations with weak signals: to improve the reception, change to monaural sound.

In RADIO mode, press MO.ST to switch between mono and stereo broadcast.

SET THE ALARM TIMER

This system can be used as an alarm timer. You can select CD, Radio, USB, SD or Buzzer as alarm source.



Make sure that you have set the clock correctly.

- 1. In standby mode, press and hold **TIMER** on main unit or remote control until 1 icon and ON (Alarm ON) appeared on display.
- 2. The hour digits blink, press I◄◄ / ►►I to set the hour then press TIMER to confirm.
- 3. The minute digits blink, press I◄◄ / ►►I to set the hour then press TIMER to confirm.


- 4. Display appeared oFF (Alarm OFF)
- 5. Repeat steps 2-3 to set the alarm off.
- 6. Press TIMER to confirm
- 7. Press ◄◄ / ▶►I repeatedly to select a source BUZZER/RADIO/CD/USB/SD
- 8. Press TIMER to confirm
- 9. Then display appeared U-10 and blink.
- 10. Press I◄◄ / ▶►I to set the wake up volume level then press TIMER to confirm.



If the system is idle for 60 seconds, it exits alarm setting mode automatically.

TO ACTIVATE OR DEACTIVATE THE ALARM TIMER

In standby mode, press **TIMER** button repeatedly to activate or deactivate the alarm.



When the ALARM sounds ON, press () or TIMER button on main unit or remote control to turn off the alarm sound.



If CD,USB or SD is selected as alarm source, yet there is no disc inserted or no USB/ card connected, the system switches to the BUZZER source automatically.

SET THE SLEEP TIMER



Make sure that you have set the clock correctly.

When the system is turned on, press **SLEEP** repeatedly to select the sleep timer period (in minutes) OFF- 10-20......90.

If the sleep timer is activated, [SLEEP] is displayed.

To deactivate the sleep timer:

Press **SLEEP** repeatedly until [OFF] is displayed.

AUDIO IN (AUX)

You can also listen to an external audio device through this system.

- 1. Connect the audio cable (not supplied) to the AUX-in socket (3.5mm) on the system
- 2. Press SOURCE button repeatedly to select AUX mode.
- 3. Play the external audio device (see the user manual of the device).
- 4. Adjust the main volume on the external device and main unit.

Note: Please always turn the volume level to the maximum on external device.

Otherwise, the main unit will switch to standby mode (ECO mode) as no audio signal input. This is not a mal-function.
