





Thank you for your purchase of this alarm clock. Please read these instructions carefully and keep the manual well for future reference.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Place your clock face down on a flat and soft surface.
- 2. Remove the battery cover at the back of your unit.
- Insert 2 x new AAA batteries into the battery compartment by observing the correct "+" and "-" polarity.
- 4. Replace the battery cover.

Remarks:

- Alkaline batteries are recommended for optimal usage of this clock.
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard or rechargeable batteries.

When the battery life is short, the back light and night light may not function as normal.

TO SET TIME, 12/24 HR TIME AND SNOOZE DURATION

- Press and hold SET/ALM, the hour digits flash. Press ▲ or ▼ to set the hours. Press and hold ▲ or ▼ will accelerate setting in fast speed.
- 2. Press **SET/ALM** once again, the minute digits flash. Press ▲ or ▼ to set the minutes. Press and hold ▲ or ▼ will accelerate setting in fast speed.
- 3. Press SET/ALM once again, 24Hr flash, press ▲ or ▼ to select 12Hr ⇔ 24Hr. In 12Hr mode, PM will appear on the display to indicate afternoon time. There is no AM indicator.
- 4. Press **SET/ALM** once again, **2014** flash and **∃** rappears. Press **▲** or **v** to set the years.
- 5. Press **SET/ALM** once again, the month digits flash. Press ▲ or ▼ to set month.
- 6. Press **SET/ALM** once again, the date digits flash. Press ▲ or ▼ to set date.
- Press SET/ALM once again, the Month 1. Date 1 flash. Press ▲ or ▼ to select Month-date or Date-Month display.
- 8. Then press **SET/ALM** once again, **EN** flash. Press ▲ or ▼ to select the language of day of week.

EN = English

DU = Dutch

SP = Spanish

- 10. Press **SET/ALM** again or if no key pressed for approx. 10 seconds to exit the setting mode.

TO SET ALARM 1

At normal time display, press **SET/ALM** once, **6:00 (AM)** and **A** appears.

- Press and hold SET/ALM until the hour digit flash. Then press ▲ or ▼ to set alarm 1's hours.
 Press and hold ▲ or ▼ to accelerate setting in fast speed. PM will appear on the display to indicate afternoon time. There is no AM indicator.
- Press SET/ALM once again, alarm's 1 minute digits flash. Then press ▲ or ▼to set alarm 1's minutes.

3. Press **SET/ALM** once again or if no key pressed for approx. 10 seconds to exit the Alarm 1's setting mode.

TO SET ALARM 2

- 1. At normal time display, press **SET/ALM** twice, **6:00 (AM)** and **R 2** appears.
- Press and hold SET/ALM until the hour digits flash. Then press ▲ or ▼ to set Alarm 2's hours.
 Press and hold ▲ or ▼ to accelerate setting in fast speed. PM will appear on the display to indicate afternoon time. There is no AM indicator.
- 3. Press **SET/ALM** once again, the minute digits flash. Then press ▲ or ▼ to set Alarm 2's minutes.
- 4. Press **SET/ALM** once again or if no key pressed for approx. 10 seconds to exit the Alarm 2's setting mode.

TO TURN ON OR OFF ALARM 1 AND 2

- 1. At normal time display, press **ALM/ ON.OFF** once to activate Alarm 1, **1** appears.
- 2. Press ALM/ ON.OFF once again to activate Alarm 2, 2 appears.
- 3. Press ALM/ ON.OFF again to activate both Alarm 1 and 2, both 1 and 2 appear.
- 4. Press ALM/ ON.OFF again to deactivate both alarms (both 1) and 2) disappear).

TO STOP AND RESET THE ALARM TO COME ON THE NEXT DAY

When alarm 1 or 2 is sounding, the related alarm icon flashes. Press the **ALM/ ON.OFF** once to stop the alarm and reset it to come on the following day. After that both and/or remains on the display.

TO ACTIVATE THE SNOOZE FUNCTION (default snooze duration is 5 minutes)

When alarm is sounding, press **Zz** • 🌋 once, the alarm will be silenced and come on again after the set snooze duration.

Note: if your second alarm activates while the first alarm is sounding or it is in the snooze mode, the second alarm overrides the first alarm (the first alarm is reset to come on the next day).

TO ACTIVATE THE NIGHT LIGHT FUNCTION

Your clock has a night light function which illuminates the LCD display for you to view time in a dark environment.

- At normal time display mode, press and hold **Zz ☆** until the **☆** appear and **OFF** flash. Then press ▲ or ▼ to select night light **ON** or **OFF**.
- Press Zz ★ once again, 12:00 (AM) flash, then press ▲ or ▼ to select Night Light starting hours.
- 3. Press **Zz •** ★ once again, **6 Hr** appears, then press ▲ or ▼ to select Night Light on duration **5 Hr / 6 Hr / 7 Hr**

TO VIEW DEGREE CELSIUS OR DEGREE FAHRENHEIT TEMPERATURE READOUT Simply press ▼ / C / F to select degree Celsius or degree Fahrenheit temperature readout.

TO USE BACKLIGHT

At normal time display mode, simply press **Zz**• 🎇 once to activate the backlight for 5 seconds.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

If your clock displays irrelevant time or does not function properly, which maybe caused by electrostatic discharge or other interference, open the battery cover, take out the batteries a few seconds and reinstall them by observing the correct +/- polarity. Your unit will be reset to default settings and you need to set it again.

CARE OF YOUR PRODUCT

- Place your unit on a stable surface, away from sources of direct sunlight or excessive heat or moisture.
- 2. Protect your furniture when placing your units on a natural wood and lacquered finish by using a cloth or protective material between it and the furniture.
- 3. Clean your unit with a soft cloth moistened only with mild soap and water. Stronger agents such as Benzine, thinner or similar materials can damage the surface of the unit. Make sure the unit is unplugged before cleaning.
- 4. Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadimium) batteries.
- 5. If the unit is not to be used for a prolonged period, such as a month or longer, remove the batteries to prevent possible corrosion. Should the battery compartment become corroded or dirty, clean the compartment thoroughly and replace the batteries.

EN Warranty conditions

Warranty card is not a part of the device packaging.

This product is warranted for the period of 24 months from the date of purchase to the end-user. Warranty is limited to the following conditions. Warranty is referred only to the customer goods using for common domestic use. The claim for service can be applied either at dealer's shop where the product was bought, or at below mentioned authorized service shops. The end-user is obligated to set up a claim immediately when the defects appeared but only till the end of warranty period. The end user is obligated to cooperate to certify the claiming defects. Only completed and clean (according to hygienic standards) product will be accepted. In case of eligible warranty claim the warranty period will be prolonged by the period from the date of claim application till the date of taking over the product by end-user, or the date the end-user is obligated to take it over. To obtain the service under this warranty, end-user is obligated to certify his claim with duly completed following documents: receipt, certificate of warranty, certificate of installation.
