
Thank you for purchasing the SADES Pegasus. Please read the provided instructions carefully before assembling your device, and strictly follow the manual in regards to the device's operation and use.


#### **NOTES:**

- 1. Please make sure the product does not get in contact with fire, direct sunlight and wet environments.
- 2. Do not put the chair on high or unstable places to avoid the danger of falling.
- 3. Put the chair on flat ground.
- 4. Pay attention to your kids when they are climbing the chair.
- 5. Please pay attention to the natural loosening of the bolts after long-term use, avoid sharp things scratching the chair.
- 6. Please avoid excessive tilting to prevent the danger of falling.
- 7. The full installation takes 30-40 minutes.


Please strictly follow all the installation steps. Accessories should be installed properly before locking them in place with the related screws. Left and Right signs correspond to your left and right side when you sit in front of the table.

## **Assembly Guide**

#### STEP 1: PUT THE BACK REST AND SEAT TOGETHER

Put the back rest and seat together as shown in picture 1. Pay attention to the spot marked in red, which needs to be aimed at the bolt holes.

REMOVE THE PRE-MOUNTED BOLTS ON THE BACKREST BEFORE PERFORMING STEP 1! The two bolts are located on each side of the back rest. Please aim at the bolt holes when putting the back rest and seat together.



#### STEP 2: LOCK THE BACK REST AND SEAT

Lock the 4 bolts on the left and right side in place as shown in picture 2.

Begin on the right side, where the tilting handle is located. Screw both bolts on the right side half way in and then screw in the two bolts on the left side. Afterwards, tighten the bolts on both sides.



#### **STEP 3: INSTALL THE RECLINER COVERS**

Attach the lower snap button first. Lock the screw into the hole on the recliner cover, and then attach the screw cover onto it.






#### **STEP 4: INSTALL THE MECHANISM**

Use the bolts to lock the mechanism and the seat together, make sure the bolts are screwed in tight.


The bolts are pre-mounted on the seat, please remove them and then lock the mechanism and seat together with the bolts. Please make sure the direction of the mechanism is the same as on the diagram.

Lastly, install the handles. Please make sure that the direction of the handles is the same to the diagram when you're installing them.






**STEP 5: INSTALL THE WHEELS** 





#### **STEP 6: INSTALL THE GAS SPRING**



Please remove the protective cover at the top of the gas spring before installing it.

### STEP 7: PUT ON THE GAS SPRING COVER



#### STEP 8: PUT THE CHAIR BODY ON THE GAS SPRING

Aim at the top of the gas spring and the hole of the mechanism, then put the chair body down.





### **Warranty Conditions**

A new product purchased in the Alza.cz sales network is under warranty for 2 years. If you need repair or other services during the warranty period, contact the product seller directly, you must provide the original proof of purchase with the original date of purchase. Copies of proof of purchase of the product, altered, supplemented, without the original data or otherwise damaged proof of purchase of the product will not be considered as proof of purchase of the claimed product.
